What to do if you're involved in an accident

- Do NOT leave the scene.
- Help any injured, but don't move them unless absolutely necessary.
- Call the police.
- Get names, addresses, and phone and driver's license numbers of all drivers.
- Get descriptions and license plate numbers of all cars involved.
- Diagram the accident, showing all cars involved.
- Do not place or accept blame for the accident.
- Make an immediate report to the police.
- Notify your parents immediately so they can contact their insurance agent or SECURA.
